Teach me, Visual Communication Festival promoted by the University Iuav of Venice - Faculty of Arts and Design.

Conceived as creativity lab and party, with a multidisciplinary transversal approach, Teach me is an observatory on the changes in the contemporary world, an opportunity to reflect, that experiments new alternative ways of learning and interaction between students and teachers. This year the festival will deal with the connection between music and visual communication, relation that doesn't just mean cover art: today music is expressed through visual channels, videos and films, digital elaborations, visual engineering for live events, specialised magazines, music televisions, radio, web.

Exploring those areas is the main aim of Teach me 4, together with the the best professionals in the fields, among which: **Mike Mills, Laurent Fetis, Syrup Helsinki, Åbäke, Luca De Gennaro (MTV), Carlo Antonelli (Rolling Stone), Francesco Meneghini, Riotmaker, I Ragazzi Della Prateria, Fabio De Luca, Andy Cameron, Carlo Branzaglia, Patrizia Convertino, Francesco Messina, Marco Cendron, Brian Duffy, Martyn Ware** and many more.

From the 26th to the 28th professionals, teachers and students will work side by side: during the three days, workshops will take place in-between suggestions and hints of designers working in the music field, and everything will be documented live with videos, drawings, interviews and pod-casts, materials that will be available on the web site.

Musical appetisers, dj sets and visual performances will also be part of the event On the final night, Friday the 28th, a special exclusive live event will feature Brian Duffy and Martyn Ware with the Modified Toy Orchestra followed by the closure concert by **Ex-Otago**, live also on Second Life, virtual world accessible via www.secondlife.com.
